Information sharing and analytics are key ingredients to success in any criminal justice investigation.

Agencies must cross jurisdictional lines to gather the necessary data to make informed decisions.

Public Records

Combining public records with the criminal data already existing in the system makes it the most powerful investigative tool on the market

- Possible employers, neighbors, relatives, and associates
- Location information such as addresses used, property deeds, and property foreclosures
- Driver's license information and vehicle registrations
- Sex offender registrations and more

SSA Death Master File

Eliminate time wasted looking for a person wanted for a warrant, as a suspect, or any other reason - when he is already deceased

- Records of individuals who died after 1962
- Social Security Number, Name, Birth/Death dates
- Last state and ZIP code of residence and ZIP code where lump sum death payment benefit was sent

Visitor Logs

Find out who is visiting an offender behind bars

- Name, address and phone number of the visitor
- Relationship of visitor to the offender

N-DEX

Additional information from other jurisdictions can help provide a more complete picture for your investigation

- Managed by the FBI
- Provides access to local, tribal, state and federal data sources
- Supports multi-jurisdictional task forces
- A MOU is required with N-DEX, the state chief security officer, and the requesting agency/state

OFAC SDN List

Find out if the person you are looking for is on the Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) Specially Designated Nationals (SDN) list:

- Individuals controlled by, or acting for or on behalf of, targeted countries
- Individuals, groups, and entities, such as terrorists and narcotics traffickers designated under programs that are not country-specific

Phone Data Search

Track down additional phone numbers and addresses that a sex offender, absconded parolee or other wanted individual may be using

- Provides access to U.S. landline and cell phone records
- Provides users another piece of information to track down a wanted individual
