Under federal law, incarcerated individuals cannot receive Social Security benefits. State and local correctional and certain mental health institutions are offered incentive payments for reporting information that results in suspension of Social Security payments in certain instances.

Revenue Generation

For every Social Security or SSI recipient who is suspended as a result of information provided by the participating institutions, SSA will pay the institution:

- \$400 for information received within 30 days of confinement
- \$200 for information received between 31 and 90 days of confinement

Uses

- Set up watches for wanted persons or suspects
