

## **Crash reports now available online**

The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles is now offering online access to crash reports for people involved in traffic accidents.

BuyCrash.com, which launched in Florida on Wednesday, allows involved parties to avoid a trip to the local police agency by purchasing and downloading a copy of the crash report online. Reports cost \$16, said Rick Jones, a spokesman for Appriss, the technology company that runs the Website.

The website is part of Florida's Integrated Report Exchange System, or FIRES, which includes free software tools and services for law enforcement agencies to help them collect, file, retrieve and analyze crash records.
