Free offering of data service continues for sheriffs

The nation's sheriffs will hear the latest update on JusticeXchange at this year's National Sheriffs' Association annual conference in St. Louis. Appriss will be demonstrating its unique information-sharing platform at the show on Monday, June 20. Former law enforcement executive Jim Acquisto will be making the presentation.
