- Date of Birth and Age Range field on VINELink have been made configurable, like Name search.



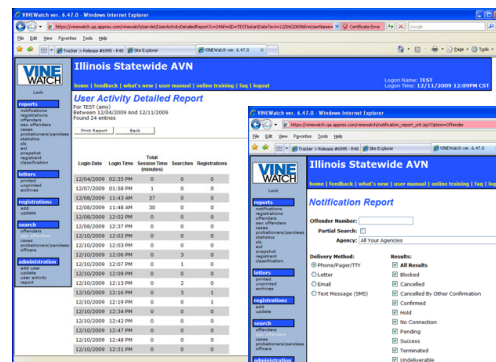
- Your VINEWatch user account can now automatically access and log you in to Appriss University, where you can complete various VINE training sessions

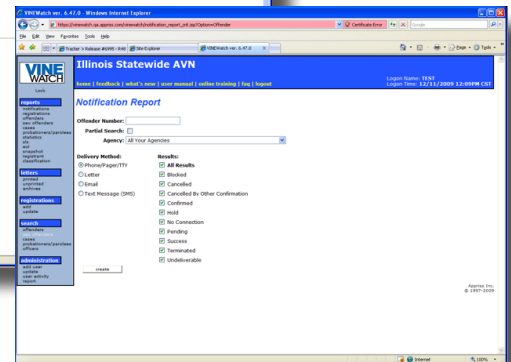
- Added 1-866-277-7477 to each mention of 1-866-APPRISS for ease of use for mobile users.
- Add the ability to disable a registration against an offender with a delete date.



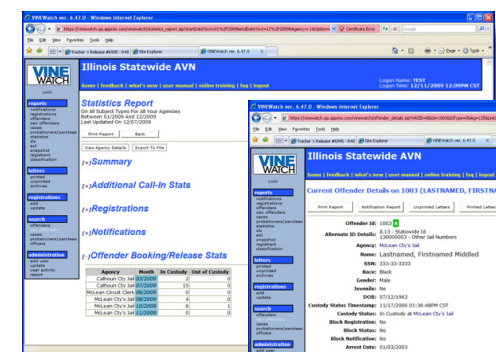

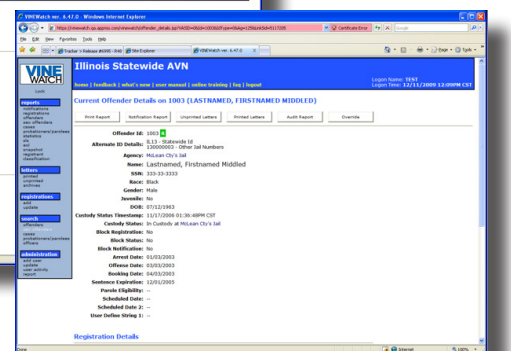
