Case information is collected automatically in near real-time from court management systems through Appriss-designed and -maintained data adapters. The adapters encrypt the data and transmit it to Appriss, where it is validated, standardized, and stored for use by victims.

Across the country, crime victims and other concerned citizens are using VINE for access to timely and reliable information about criminal cases and the custody status of offenders 24 hours a day — over the telephone, through the Internet, or by e-mail.

Victims can call to inquire about the current status of an offender and register to be notified immediately in the event of an offender's release, escape, or transfer.
