

## JusticeXchange Celebrates Five Years!


This month marks the five year anniversary of JusticeXchange. Since its beginning in March 2002 in Arkansas, JusticeXchange has now expanded to 14 states across the country. Almost 30 states are now contributing data, including over 23 million booking records and 3 million photos! Thanks to everyone for making JusticeXchange such a valuable tool!

## Latest Web Enhancements

The first Web release of 2007 is just around the corner and contains many new, exciting features! The following enhancements are included in the March 28th release:

- The ability to run a complete listing of all states/agencies submitting data to JusticeXchange via the Accessible Data tab
- Administrator Usage Reports by agency level
- Functionality to save wanted posters for emailing and future use
- Vehicle Search results grouped together just like the Person Search results. This means once the vehicle you are looking for is found in the search results, you have instant access with the click of a mouse to see all records for that specific vehicle. (Texas only)
- The ability to search phone numbers
- Up to three unique identifiers (Social Security Number, Drivers License Number, State ID, FBI #, and Phone Number) can be searched at the same time on the Person Search page

- SEARCH** (SEARCH, RESET, CLEAR buttons)
- Search Method**: A Logic Search will return matches that phonetically sound alike, are spelled similarly, and have numbers that may be slightly transposed. It is an effective tool in helping locate individuals who may change the spelling of their last name or switch a couple digits of a date of birth when encountering law enforcement. An Exact Search will return only those records that match your search criteria exactly. Radio buttons for Logic Search (selected) and Exact Search.
- Name Search Criteria**: Last Name, First Name, Middle Name, and Moniker input fields.
- Unique Identifiers**: Enter up to three unique identifiers for your search. Fields for ID Type (None, Social Security, State Id, Drivers License Number, Phone Number) and ID Number.
- Physical Description**: Fields for DOB (MM/DD/YYYY), Age (Unknown), Height (Unknown), Gender (Any), Race (Any), and other physical attributes.

## New York Parole Absconder Caught in Georgia

Charles Sears, Parole Officer with the Absconder Search Unit of the New York State Division of Parole, had been looking for a male who had been classified as a parole absconder for six months. He used the watch feature and received the notice that the man was arrested in Dekalb County in Georgia. He then looked up his booking photo and was able to verify that the man was the one he had been looking for. Sears immediately notified DeKalb County Jail and advised them that the suspect was wanted by New York State Parole, and he would be extraditing him back to New York.

## How Do You Use JusticeXchange?

In December, over 1,000 users of JusticeXchange were emailed a survey asking for feedback on the system. Approximately 240 users responded to the survey which included many success stories that will be published in future editions of The Xchange and future wants of the system that will be seen in upcoming Web releases. In addition, many uses of JusticeXchange were given that are useful to share with others. These include the following:

- Search and watch sex offenders, probationers/parolees, suspects, wanted individuals, auto thieves, and missing persons
- Review address information to track down wanted offenders
- Research information to help locate individuals to serve new and old warrants
- Create photo lineups and wanted posters
- Use photos for missing persons cases
- Review bond information
- Look up individuals who have missed their court date
- Key information source for investigations
- Review previous arrest information
- Use photos to compare webcam and security camera footage
- Confirm information a suspect may give, such as an individual says he didn't commit the crime because he was locked up in a county jail in another state at the time
